

What Verity Catches

A focused look at the detection capabilities behind every Verity Docket deliverable.

This example uses a synthetic 36-page PI medical record set across 10 documents and 5 providers. No real patient or case data is represented.

Cross-Source Inconsistency Detection

Verity Docket automatically cross-references facts across every document in the record set. When sources disagree, the inconsistency is flagged with exact citations so you can evaluate the impact on your case.

Example from this record set:

Inconsistency	Statement A	Statement B
Date discrepancy	Accident date referenced as March 15, 2024 (Chen_Orthopedic_Initial, p. 1)	Accident date referenced as 03/14/2024 (City_General_ER_Records, p. 1)

Why this matters: A one-day discrepancy in accident date across the orthopedic intake and the ER record could surface in deposition or IME review. Catching it during record review — not during cross-examination — is the point.

OCR Quality Flags

When a document requires optical character recognition (scanned pharmacy records, faxed imaging reports), Verity flags the specific documents affected so you know where transcription accuracy may be degraded.

1 document required OCR text extraction: Scanned_Pharmacy_Records.pdf

Action: Verify text accuracy in OCR-processed documents. Key dates, names, and medical terms may contain recognition errors.

Treatment Gap Analysis

For PI medical matters, Verity calculates the gap between consecutive treatment dates across the full provider timeline. Gaps exceeding 90 days are flagged automatically — the kind of continuity-of-care issue that defense counsel and IME reviewers look for.

In this record set: No gaps exceeding 90 days were detected. Treatment was continuous from 03/15/2024 (ER visit) through 08/01/2024 (final PCP follow-up).

Missing Record Detection

Verity cross-references records mentioned across the document set against records actually provided. If a provider note references imaging, a referral, or a prior visit that was not included in the upload, it is flagged.

In this record set: No missing-record flags were detected. All referenced records were present.

Every Fact Is Source-Cited

Every entry in the treatment timeline, every inconsistency flag, every gap detection references the exact source document and page number. Nothing is asserted without a citation you can verify against the original record.

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
